Message from the Executive Director

Dear Friends,

In fiscal year 2009 we were presented with many challenges as the need for food resources grew with tougher economic times and increasing unemployment. Our partner food pantries, soup kitchens, homeless shelters and many more organizations saw unprecedented increases in the number of families seeking food assistance, many for the first time.

With your support we were able to distribute 5,103,762 pounds of grocery products to 285 partner agencies in 42 Iowa counties. 142,208 households made up of 410,993 individuals received food through a food pantry; 5,661,811 meals were served to hungry Iowans through on-site feeding programs.

Through our Backpack Buddies program we were able to send home 14,451 sacks of food to 585 low income children on a weekly basis. The HUSH (Help Us Stop Hunger) program provided 320,898 pounds of ground venison statewide.

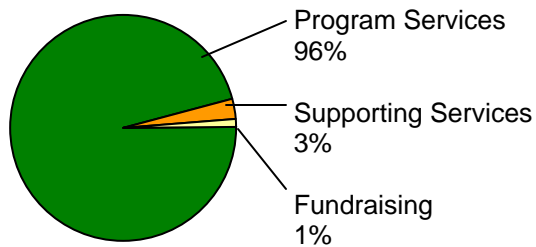
In order to better position ourselves to meet the increasing demand and feed hungry Iowans we began a strategic planning process and participated in the Feeding America Hunger Study 2010.

As we begin another year, I am more hopeful than ever about the impact the Food Bank of Iowa is making in the lives of hungry Iowans.
